FUNDING GUIDELINES

Firstly we invite you to read the objects of the Trust set out in “about us”. This will give you insight into our charitable aims and what we fund.

Our wish is to be able to help. Our attitude is flexible yet we require projects to be of high quality and impacting to the benefit of the vulnerable and disadvantaged.

Projects should have potential to benefit more than just a local application by encouraging funding and involvement from other organisations. Some of these may even be difficult to fund.

Areas of interest to the Trust are for example, education, health, social welfare, homelessness, poverty and promotion of religious belief.

Exceptional applications outside these areas may be considered.

Please adhere to the minimum requirements given below.

The Trust considers applications twice yearly. Applications should arrive by April 15 and October 15th.

The Trust supports

- General running and core costs (time limit applied)
- Capital costs for buildings and equipment
- Various project costs and some overhead costs
- Projects which are likely to roll in other funding sources

We do not support

- Endowments
- General appeals
- Repayment of debts
- Organisations who have been supported in the last 12 months
- Emergency funding
